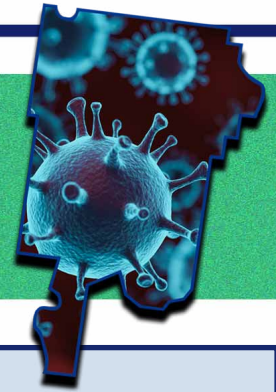




CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



FOR EMPLOYEES

COVID-19 Symptomatic:

Employees should monitor their health for symptoms of COVID-19 and follow these steps if experiencing any symptoms:

- Do not report to work
- Notify supervisor
- Consult medical provider

COVID-19 Positive Test Results:

Employees diagnosed (test positive) with COVID-19

- Do not report to work
- Consult medical provider
- Report diagnosis to supervisor
- Remain out of work as directed by the medical provider and CCPS Health Team
- Leave is entered as sick leave

COVID-19 Exposure: If an employee is vaccinated or unvaccinated and deemed a close contact in the work environment but **NOT** exhibiting symptoms:

- Report to work
- No quarantine required
- Practice social distancing, complete COVID screener each day, temperature check, sanitize hands, monitor symptoms, COVID-19 Test in 3-5 days from exposure
- CCPS Health Team may follow-up

COVID-19 Exposure: If an employee is **NOT** vaccinated or employee **IS** vaccinated but exhibiting symptoms:

- Report exposure to supervisor
- Supervisor will report exposure to the Health Team
- Quarantine
- The Health Team will determine next steps
- COVID-19 test no sooner than 3 to 5 days of exposure; a negative test may reduce the number of quarantine days
- If the quarantine is a result of exposure in the work environment, the employee will be paid for quarantine days and is expected to work remotely when feasible or applicable

FOR STUDENTS

COVID-19 Symptomatic:

Every student and family should monitor their health daily and, if an immediate family member receives a COVID-19-positive diagnosis or if the student is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, he or she should not report to school:

- Do not report to school
- Consult medical provider
- Notify a school staff member

COVID-19 Positive Test Results:

If a student is diagnosed (tested positive) with COVID-19:

- Do not report to school
- Consult medical provider
- Report diagnosis to teacher or building principal
- Principal will properly report the positive diagnosis and then conducts contact tracing
- Remain out of school as directed by COVID-19 Response Team

COVID-19 Exposure: Every student and family should monitor their health daily and, if an immediate family member receives a COVID-19-positive diagnosis or if the student is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, he or she should not report to school:

If Student is Vaccinated: No quarantine unless symptomatic

If Student is not Vaccinated

- If contact is greater than 6 feet, no quarantine
- If both students are masked and contact between students is greater than 3 feet and plexi-glass is available, no quarantine
- If both students are not masked, no plexi-glass is available, and contact is less than 6 feet for 15 minutes or more, 10-days of quarantine required
- If a student is asymptomatic (no symptoms), a negative COVID-19 test (no sooner than 3 to 5 days of exposure) may reduce quarantine time
- CCPS Health Team may follow-up

Student Learning During Quarantine due to COVID-19

- The goal is to ensure that students who have to quarantine have continued access to learning while at home
- Students will receive their assignments from their teachers. Assignments may require digital access to CANVAS, Google Applications, and/ or other digital and print resources
- For digital assignments, students will need access to a computer device and reliable Internet
- Students may be able to work asynchronously (independently) while at home, or they may be required to access their teachers' classroom Zoom links to log into the lesson to learn synchronously (teacher-led). The learning method is contingent upon the school principal's procedures and/or if a student is symptomatic and not able to log in for live instruction
- Students and their parents are asked to remain in communication with their child's teachers if there are questions about students' assignments
